



The Army's Commitment to Victims of Sexual Assault:

- Encouraging victims to report all incidents of sexual assault
- Ensuring victims are properly treated
- Ensuring medical and psychological needs are properly met
- Providing effective policies and programs
- Prosecuting all crimes to the full extent of the law
- Consideration of all issues related to the incident

Crime Victims have the Right to:

- Be treated with fairness and respect for one's dignity and privacy
- Be reasonably protected from the accused
- Be notified of court hearings
- Be present at public court hearings unless the Court determines otherwise for fairness or other good cause
- Receive information regarding conviction, sentencing, imprisonment, and release
- Confer with the attorney for the Government
- Restitution, if appropriate
