

RULES FOR PAYDAY GOLF SCRAMBLES

1. A shotgun start will be used. Pre-assigned starting holes will be annotated on scorecards and on the golf carts.
2. United States Golf Association rules apply, except where modified by local rules. Local rules apply with the following exception: Balls played anywhere on the course may be lifted without penalty and placed within one club length, but not nearer, the hole. The one club length may not be used to take a ball out of a hazard.
3. Play in Turn. Each team player will stroke in turn on each shot. After the best shot (best ball) has been determined by the team captain, each player will play the next shot in order from the location of the best ball.
4. If a ball is inside the leather of a standard putter, it is a “gimmie”.
5. Designated tees are as follows:
 - a. Men will play from the white tees.
 - b. Women (and children 12 and under) will play from the red tees.
6. Consecutive Strokes. If a player makes two consecutive strokes prior to the remaining players making their strokes, those strokes will count against the team score.
7. Team Composition. All teams will consist of four players. Threesomes will be considered on a case-by-case basis, but will not receive additional strokes in the absence of a player.
8. Questions concerning these rules may be clarified by the Golf Course prior to the scramble.
9. Maximum score per hole – bogey.
10. Sign up on-line.
